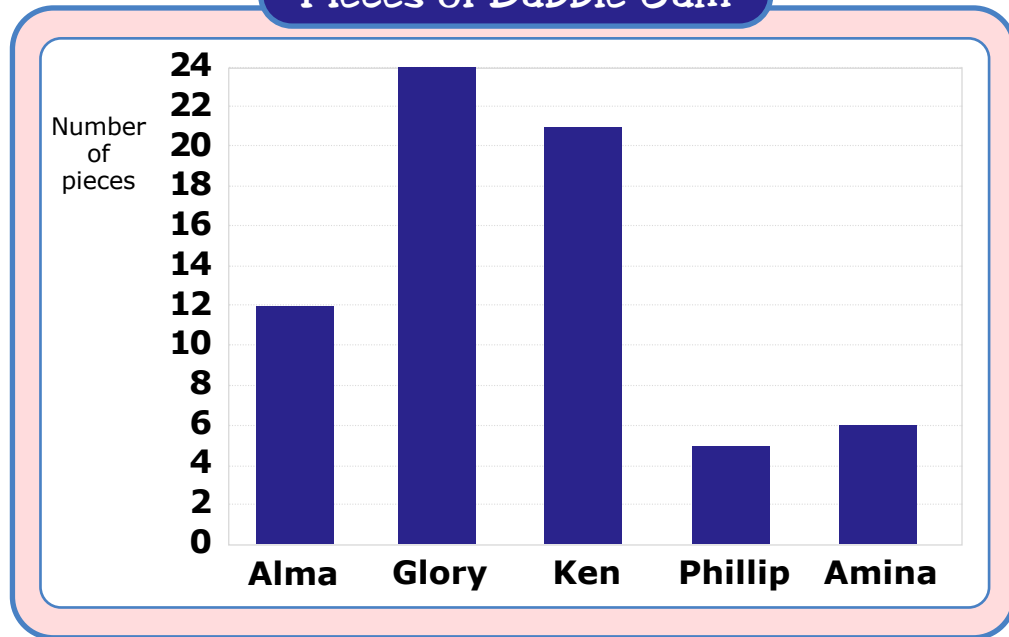

3. How many more pieces does Alma have than Amina?

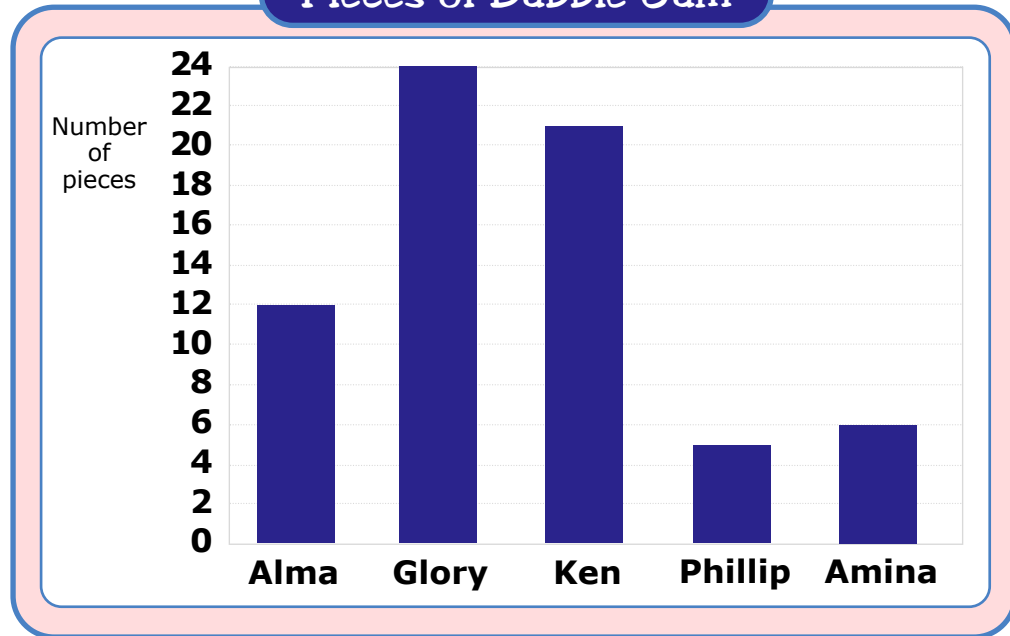
4. Who has the most pieces of bubble gum?
