- **3.** Martina delivers newspapers to 60 houses on her route. She had so many customers, she decided to give 12 customers to her brother. To how many houses does Martina deliver now?
- **4.** Louisa charges each customer the same amount to rake leaves. In one week, 3 of her customers paid her \$18.75. How much did each customer pay?
- **5.** Steven drinks 3 glasses of water a day. How many glasses of water does he drink in a week?
