Number Sentences:

George: $4 + 3 + 6 + 7 + 4 + 3 = 27$

Curious: $2 + 8 + 7 + 4 + 6 + 8 + 7 = 42$

Traffic: $8 + 7 + 2 + 3 + 3 + 4 + 2 = 29$

Wires: $9 + 4 + 7 + 3 + 7 = 30$

Fire: $3 + 4 + 7 + 3 = 17$

Zoo: $0 + 6 + 6 = 12$
