Counting Quickly

Show your child graphs in a newspaper or magazine. Point out the titles of the graphs. Talk about the numbers used in the graphs.

Community Connection

Help your child count items outside of the home, such as the number of grocery items purchased or the number of buildings passed on the way to school. When counting large quantities, count by 2s, 5s, or 10s.
