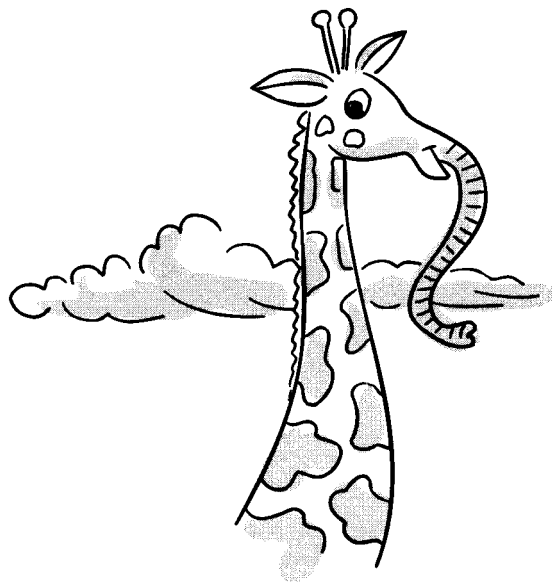


# My Mixed-Up Animal

The chameleon becomes more and more strange looking as it adds parts of other animals to its own body.

Ask children to select two real animals to put together into a single creature. One might combine an elephant and a giraffe. The resulting animal might have a trunk and a very long neck. There is a large space for a picture as this will be an important part of the assignment. Lines are provided for writing a description of the mixed-up animal. This would also make a good book.
