How many little snails can you find sliding along the branches?

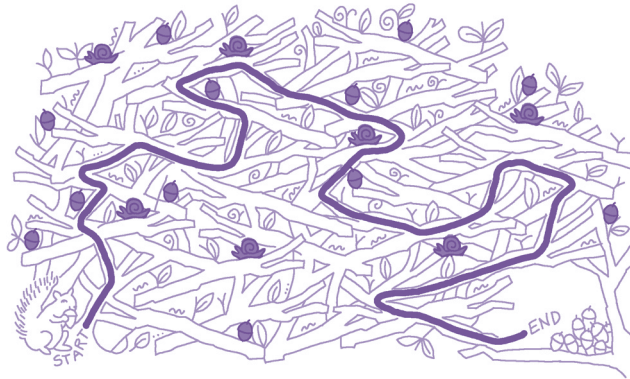
