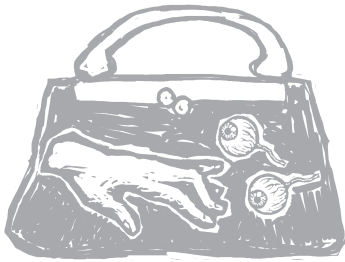


## Where does Mrs. Doctor keep spare body parts?
